Why *Hope ISO*: The Hope International Scholar's Olympiad plays a crucial role in fostering academic excellence, critical thinking, and global competitiveness among students. By providing a platform for young minds to showcase their knowledge and skills across various disciplines, it encourages intellectual curiosity and a passion for learning. This Olympiad not only challenges participants with rigorous problem-solving tasks but also nurtures their confidence, resilience, and ability to perform under pressure. Moreover, it serves as a gateway to international recognition, scholarships, and future academic opportunities, empowering students to strive for excellence. Our team has structured these Olympiads into two categories based on the requirements of the evaluation system.

1 The first one is evaluated based on chronological age, as it follows an interdisciplinary approach. This includes following 4 Olympiads.

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This Olympiad is categorized based on age groups rather than grade/class. However, to streamline the process, we have grouped certain classes together to align with the age criteria. Question papers and the preparatory e-book will be structured accordingly for each group.

2 The second category is evaluated based on the child's grade, following a disciplinary approach. This includes following 3 Olympiads.

<u>NOTE</u>: The sample papers/Preparatory E-Book & question papers will be provided grade/class wise to prepare & to conduct the test.

<u>GUIDELINES OF THE COMPETITION:</u>

- **ROUND 1**: The 1st round will be organized in the respective school's premises itself. The 1st round examination will be of 30 marks and the qualifying marks are 15 i.e. <u>'one must</u> score 15 and above to qualify so as to be eligible to participate in the 'second round'.
- **<u>ROUND 2:</u>** The 2nd round will be held for all the students, those will qualify the round-1 successfully.

<u>**1**st **Round prizes**</u>: Since it is a qualifying round, all the participating candidates will get the certificate of participation from <u>*HOPE FOUNDATION*</u> <u>**TENTATIVE DATES**</u>:

Registration Period: - <u>On or before 25th June- 2025.</u>

- <u>1st Round</u>: Decide any date in 4th week of August 2025 to organize the competition in the respective participating schools.
- <u>2nd Round</u>: To be conducted zone wise by 2nd week of December- 2025 (Exact dates & schedule will be communicated later after declaration of result of Round 1)

(*Note: -* All the winter bound Schools are requested to choose dates to conduct various levels of examination & inform about the schedule to the management of the foundation).

REGISTRATION's FEE STRUCTURE:

1stRound:

- Participation fee for 1st Round will be <u>INR 150/-</u> per student (All schools, situated in India), includes the charges of the preparatory E-Booklet.
- INR 750/- (for schools, situated outside of India) per student including all charges and the preparatory E-booklet.

<u>Note:</u> The password protected preparatory E-Book (as per the olympiads) will be mailed to every registrant within two weeks of the registration.

2ndRound:

- The participation Fee for the second round will be <u>INR 250/-</u> (All schools, situated in India).
- INR 1250/- (for schools, situated outside of India) per student.

PROCEDURE FOR COLLECTION OF REGISTRATION FEES:

The required fee (as mentioned above) is to be collected by the respective participating schools from the participants and to be deposited accordingly.
